IBA Student Societies

The IBA is a proud proponent of the student union and has an active student council for many decades. Every year, students elect their representatives for Students' Council alongside 20+ societies and clubs which operate under the Office of Student Societies. This forum allows students to explore and pursue their interests outside of the academic sphere leading to a holistic development of character, ethics and morals that the IBA promises to instill in its student body.

Information and Communication Technology (ICT) infrastructure

The Information and Communication Technology department provides ICT services to both the campuses – main and city – hostels and staff town, serving a total of around 4,500 users on-and-off campus.

- Wi-Fi connectivity, video conferencing and unified communications facilities at both campuses
- Nine general purpose computing labs are fully functional at both campuses
- Five labs with more than 300 state-of-the art desktop computers
- Smart boards in selective classrooms for interactive classroom experience

Financial Assistance

The IBA offers financial assistance to deserving students in various forms. There is a dedicated Financial Aid Office who administers financial needs of the students. Requests for financial assistance are invited in the months of June, July and August, however, keeping into consideration unforeseen and unfortunate situations, applications are accepted round the year. A Financial Assistance committee scrutinizes the applications of students seeking financial aid and sanctions the appropriate assistance for those who demonstrate the need. Financial assistance packages include but not limited to tuition fee waiver, easy installment plans, deferment of fees, loans, grants, on-campus apprenticeships and Qarz-e-Hasna schemes.

Health Centre

Martin Dow collaborated with the IBA to provide quality healthcare facilities for its students, faculty and staff. The clinic is accessible 6 days a week and provides the students of IBA with high quality medical facilities at the campus which address the concerns of the rigorous academic schedules of the students throughout the study years.



ATM and Banking facilities

To cater to the banking needs of students, faculty and staff members, a fully-operational JS Bank branch is located inside the City Campus. Both the campuses are also equipped with ATM machines installed by HBL. Furthermore, a few prominent bank branches are present within walking distance of both campuses.

Building Infrastructure

The IBA Karachi has two campuses: Main and City campus. In total, both campuses occupy a total of 53.5 acres of land. Both the existing campuses have undergone a major revamp since 2008.



Main Campus:

The IBA Main Campus is spread over 50 acres of land for educational facilities, residential complex and Boys and Girls hostels. It is located within the premises of the University of Karachi and comprises of around 40 classrooms, 8 seminar rooms, 5 computer labs, and 14 breakout rooms. These are located in the three academic buildings: Adamjee Academic Center, Abdul Razzak Tabba Building and Aman Center for Entrepreneurial Development. All instructional spaces are fully equipped with the latest audio-visual and video conferencing facilities to boost the overall learning experience.

City Campus:

The IBA City Campus is situated at Kayani Shaheed Road, Garden Road and spreads over 3.5 acres. It consists of:

- Library
- J.S Auditorium
- Gymnasium for males and females

Existing facilities include 28 classrooms and 8 computer/

ICT laboratories. The campus houses the Centers for Excellence in Executive Education (CEE), Journalism (CEJ), Information and Communication Technology (CICT), Islamic Finance (CEIF) and Office of Research Innovation and Commercialization (ORIC).

Academic, Career and Well-Being Counselling

The institute provides well-being, academic and career counselling services to students, staff and faculty. The academic and career counselling for students is provided by specialized staff and faculty members. For well-being counselling, students can login to an exclusive online portal for the institute and schedule live video counselling sessions with a dedicated team of counsellors. These sessions can be scheduled beyond the academic schedule too.


Sports Facilities

Boys and Girls Hostel

At present, 450+ full time students are availing the facilities and residential resources provided by the hostel.

Library

The library spaces and facilities have been designed keeping in view contemporary learning styles. The featured learning spaces include collaborative learning spaces, individual study spaces, multimedia facility, research nooks and spaces, leisure study spaces. The library offers:

 A rich collection of multi-disciplinary digital databases in full-text, comprising of e-books, e-journals, case studies and industry-related research analysis reports.

- · Subscription of more than 24 electronic databases that provide access to around 10,000 e-journals and 125,000
- More than 70,000 volumes in print, whereas around 2,000-3,000 new titles (on average) are procured

Transportation

The IBA facilitates the commute of students between both the campuses via a daily shuttle service offered during multiple slots throughout the day. The IBA also provides a transport service for students – who wish to avail it – coming from different areas of the city. Moreover, both campuses are easily accessible via public transport.
