- (c) not disclose the Data without the written authority of IBA (except for the purposes of fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement), and immediately notify such member where it becomes aware that a disclosure of Data may be required by law; and not transfer Data which has been obtained by or made available to the SUPPLIER within one country outside that country, or allow persons outside that country to have access to it, without the prior written approval of IBA; and
- (d) observe the provisions of, and comply with any request made or direction given by IBA in connection with, any Data Protection Laws; and
- (e) take all reasonable steps to ensure the reliability of the personnel which will have access to any Data and ensure that any employee of the SUPPLIER (or of any of the SUPPLIER's sub-contractors) requiring access to any Data gives a written undertaking not to .A; access, use, disclose or retain the Data except in performing their duties of '{}) employment and is informed that failure to comply with this undertaking may be a criminal offence and may also lead the SUPPLIER (or, as the case may be, sub-contractor) to take disciplinary action against the employee; and

Article VI ARBITRATION failing which the decision of the court law in the jurisdiction of Karachi binding to the parties. The Arbitration proceedings will be governed by the Arbitration Act, 1940 and the Substantive and procedural law of Pakistan. The venue shall be Karachi.

Article VII FORCE MAJURE

11.1 THE SUPPLIER shall not be asked for return of consideration amount, in part or full nor can be used in a court of law, when failure in providing services outlined in this Agreement is due to an event beyond the control of THE SUPPLIER and which could not have been foreseen, prevented or avoided by a judicious person of able mind and body. These include, but are not restricted to, Acts of God, Acts of public enemy (including arson and terrorist activities), Acts of Government(s), fires, floods, epidemics, strikes, freight embargoes and unusually severe weather.

Article VIII RENEWAL

12.1 This Agreement shall be renewed with mutual consent & satisfactory performance upon completion of one year if the IBA, Karachi and the SUPPLIER agree so.

Article IX TERMINATION

13.1 "IBA" may terminate this agreement if the job is not executed according to the requirement at anytime after issuing a 15 day's notice.

Article X INDEMNITY

14.1 "THE SUPPLIER" in its individual capacity shall indemnify and keep IBA and any person claiming through IBA fully indemnified and harmless from and against all damages, cost and expenses caused to or incurred by "THE SUPPLIER", as a result of any defect in the title of IBA or any fault, neglect or omission by the "THE SUPPLIER" which disturbs or damage the reputation, quality or the standard of services provided by "IBA" and any person claiming through the IBA.

Article XI NOTICE

15.1 Any notice given under this AGREEMENT shall be sufficient if it is in writing and if sent by courier or registered mail.

Article XII INTEGRITY PACT

16.1 The intention not to obtain the procurement / work of any Contract, right, interest, privilege, or other obligation or benefit from the IBA or any administrative or financial offices thereof or any other department under the control of the IBA through any corrupt practice(s).

16.2 Without limiting the generality of the forgoing the SUPPLIER, represents and warrants that it has fully declared the charges, fees, commission, taxes, levies etc, paid or payable to anyone and not given or agreed to give and shall not give or agree to give to anyone within the IBA directly or indirectly through any means any

- 16.4 Notwithstanding any right and remedies exercised by the IBA in this regard, SUPPLIER, agrees to indemnify the IBA for any loss or damage incurred by it on account of its corrupt business practice & further pay compensation to the IBA in any amount equivalent to the loss of any commission, gratification, bribe, gifts, kickback given by the SUPPLIER, as aforesaid for the purpose of obtaining or inducing procurement /work/ service or other obligation or benefit in whatsoever from the IBA.

Article XIII MISCELLANEOUS

- 17.1 The terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT have been read over to the parties which they admit to be correct and abide by the same.
- 17.2 The validity of the contract will be effective from the date of issue of Work Order.
- 17.3 All terms and conditions of tender vide # IT/07/18-19 will be the integral part of this agreement and can't be revoked.
